Requirements:

- We have 3 aircraft to bring to each show: MXS, MX2, and Beech A36 Bonanza. Each has a Length / Width hangar footprint of approximately 20' x 25'
- Fuel – Not to exceed 325 gallons total for all 3 aircraft. Grade = 100LL
- Oil – three (3) cases total for performance planes and support plane, Aeroshell W-100 Plus
- Smoke Oil - up to 10 gallons per flight (includes press rides, practice, and performance flights) Grade = Aeroshell Smoke Oil, Corvus , or Canapus 13.
- Hanger Space – A covered and secure hangar for the show aircraft (MXS and MX2), and a secure area for any support aircraft, each day and night from arrival to departure
- Lodging – Seven nights or less in up to four non-smoking rooms with king size beds at a Better Quality hotel
- Transportation – Two (2) non-smoking vehicles, one being a minivan or large SUV, and the second a mid-size car or larger, for each day from arrival to departure
- Up to 20 VIP passes and 6 parking passes for our guests
- High visibility / traffic placement for our show trailer (footprint 20' x 60') near show center and/or announcer stand
